

## FAQ Paying Cash on the Field for Referee Fees

### ASA Leagues that pay cash on the Field Listed Below Alabama State League (ASL) 2024-2025 Updated

1. **HOME TEAM:** The **HOME** team is responsible for paying the referees. Only pay the ones who are present – if an Assistant Referee does not show, **DO NOT** pay for this position. Please make sure you have the correct denomination to pay for each slot listed above. Make sure the proper amount is in EACH envelope labeled Referee, AR1, AR2 and sealed. The referees should be paid prior to kick off.
  - a. If by chance you forgot your pay envelopes, the fee **MUST** be paid before halftime. If that means you must collect from parents on the sideline, then what is what you do – Referees must be paid at the field (If agreed by the referee, they can be paid via VENMO, PayPal, etc.) Please double check before leaving home that you have envelopes, game day rosters, and coaches/player cards if needed. If you are unable to collect and pay the referees before halftime, then the game is a forfeit, and all ASA forfeit fees will be apply to the HOME team.
  - b. There will be times when a Referee does not show – **DO NOT** pay for this position. The Referee will request the HOME team to provide a club linesman as a volunteer who will call when the ball is out of bounds. If a second Assistant Referee is needed, the AWAY team will be asked to provide a club linesman.
2. **WEATHER:** Should your game be rained out PRIOR to halftime; you will have to reschedule the game. Yes, you will have to pay for another set of referees if you cannot finish the first half. Game decisions on weather is up to the Referee to determine based on Laws of the Game.

**In ASL Rules: 7.5.1 Any game that is abandoned because of inclement weather or darkness, after the completion of the first half, will be considered a completed game. If the first half has not been completed, the game will be replayed in its entirety prior to the end of the current season.**
3. **Meet in the Middle Game:** A game that is a meet in the middle, (a different location agreed by **BOTH** teams) the **HOME** team (listed first on the schedule) **WILL BE** responsible for the referee fees as stated above. **ASA will pay the field rental (if one is charged) to play the game in the middle.**
